Why did the pirate shove gold down his shirt?

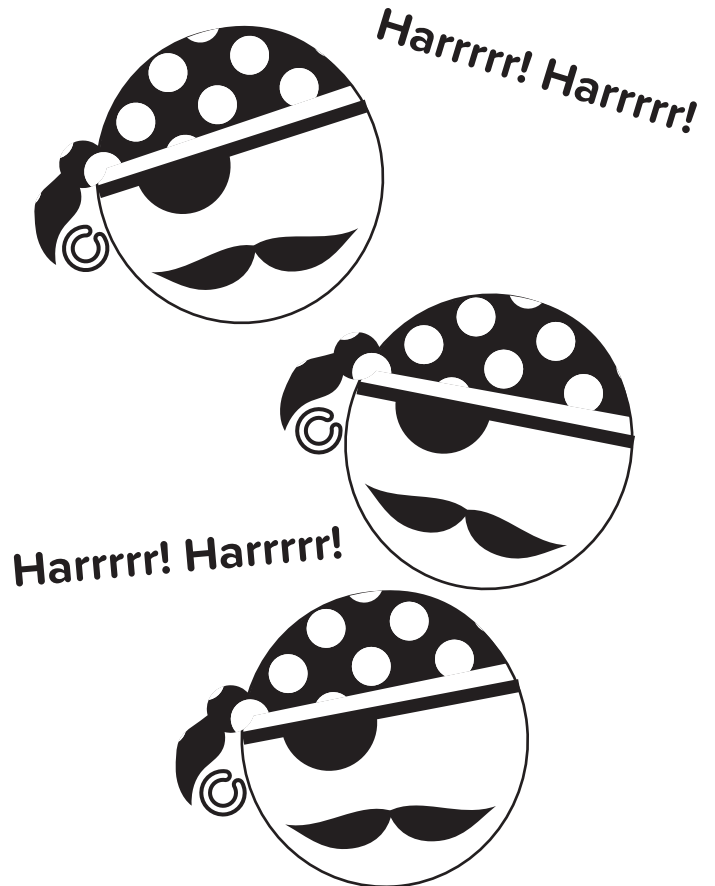
So he could have a treasure chest.
